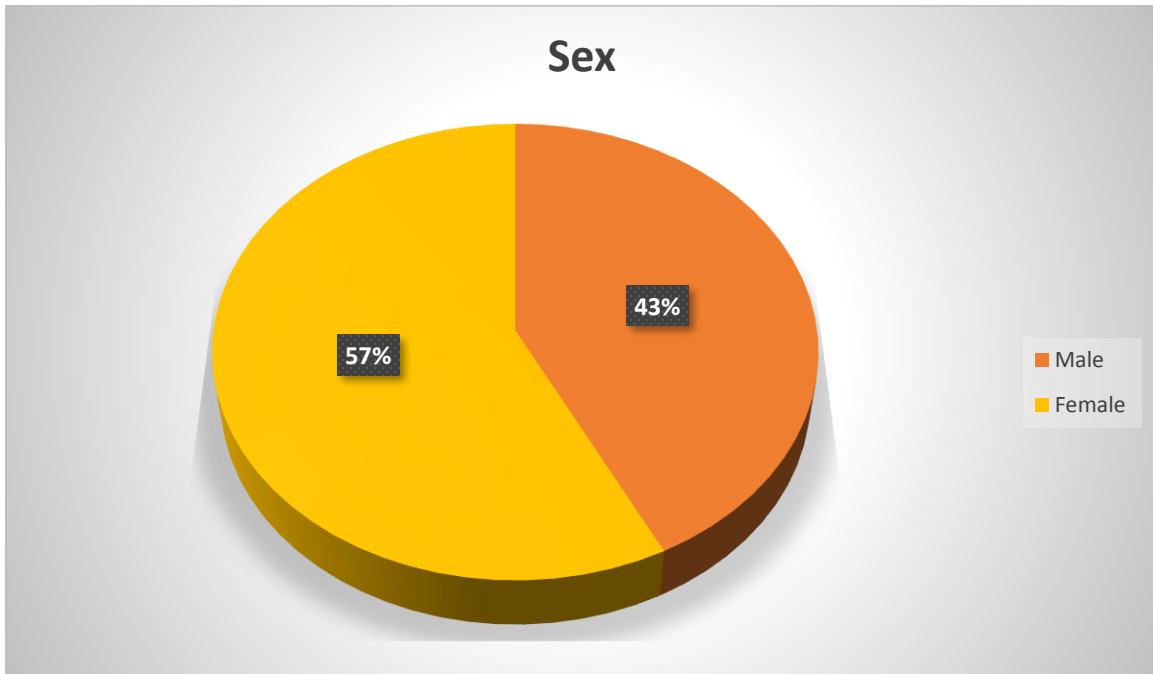

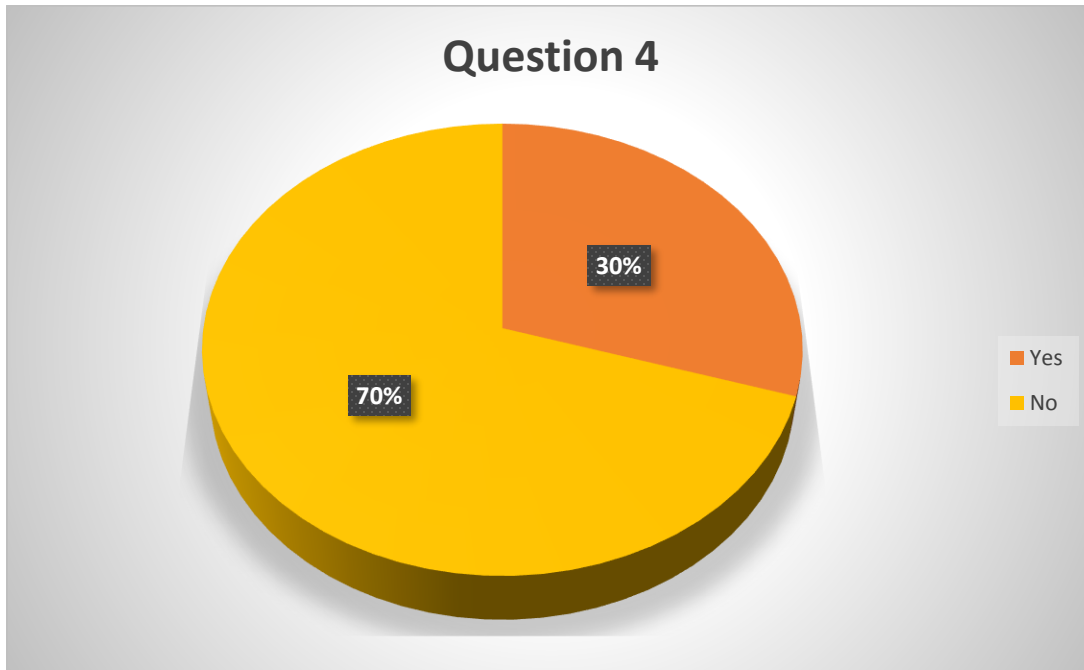

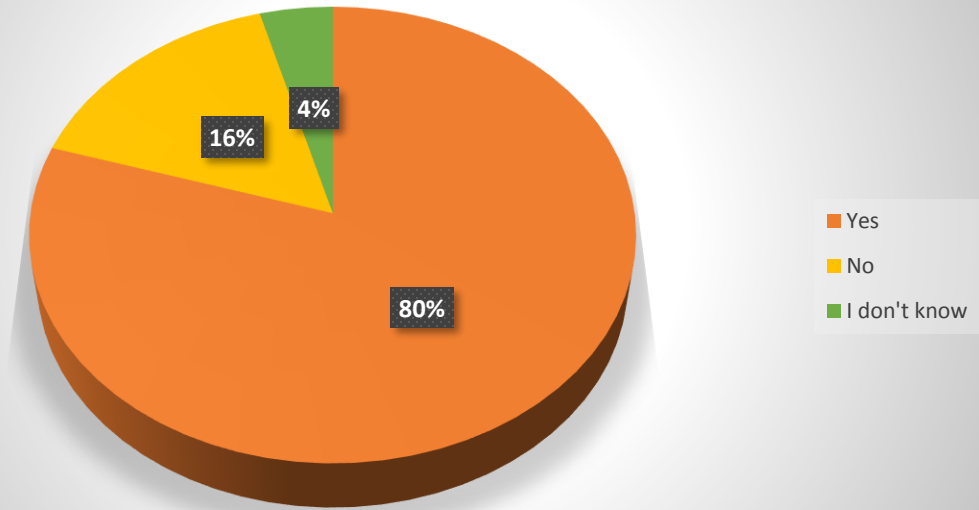

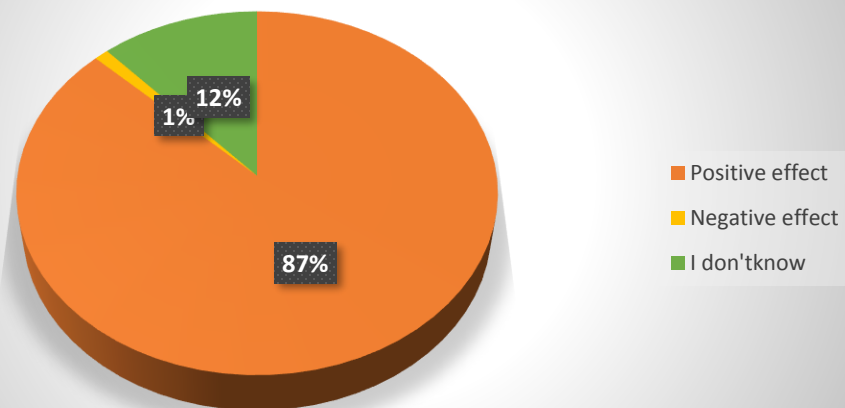

6. If your answer was yes, what effect did the career guidance activities have on your pupils? (94 RESPONSES)

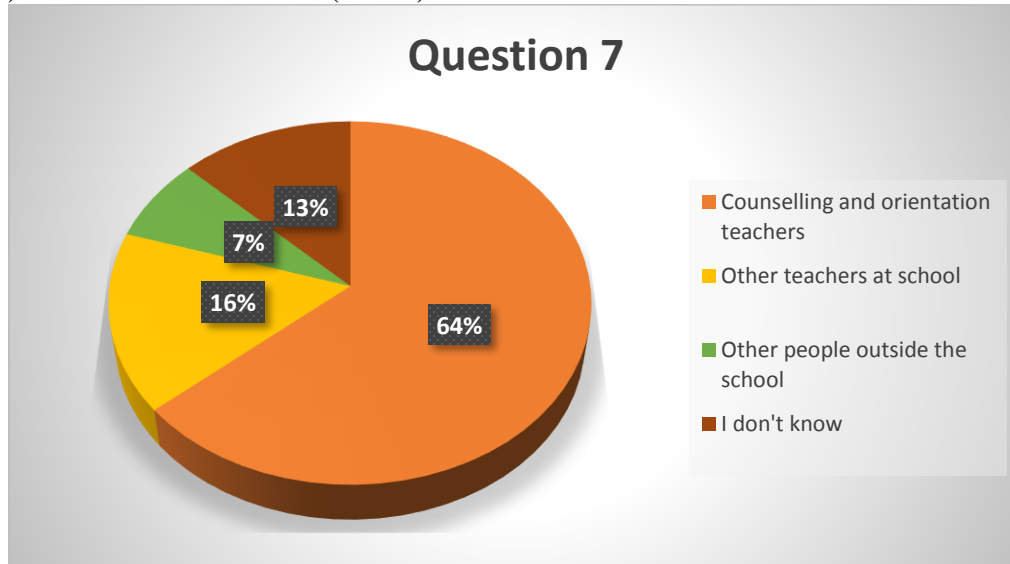
- a) **Positive effect** – 82 (87 %)

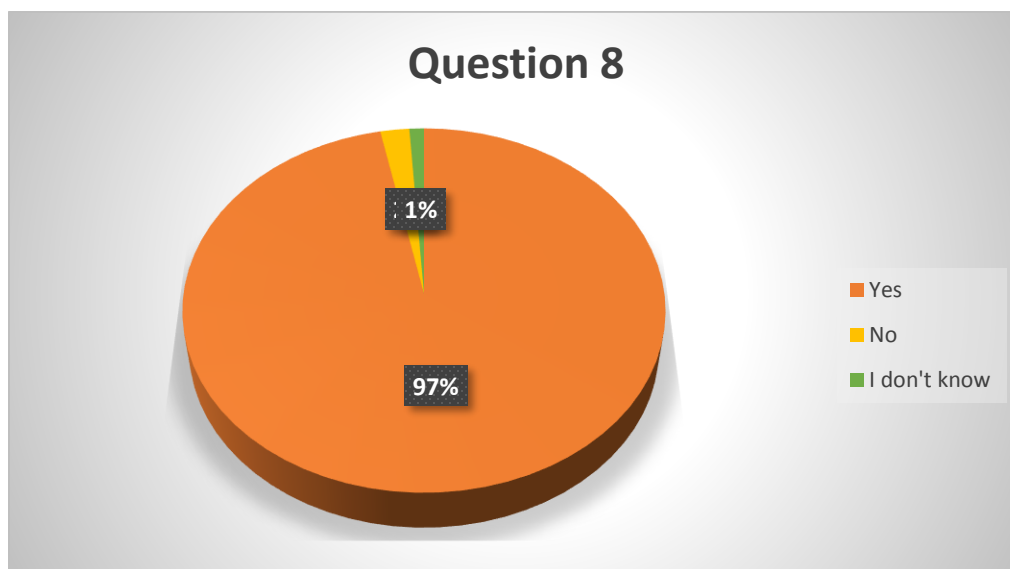
7. Who conducted the career guidance activities your pupils took part in? (94 RESPONSES)

- d) **I don't know** – 12 (13 %)



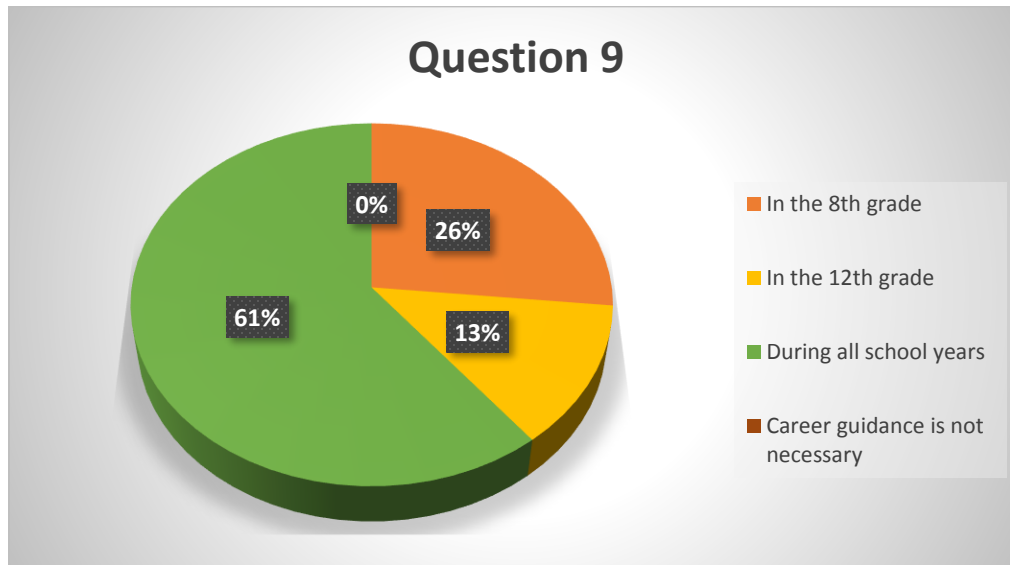
8. Do you consider that career guidance is useful and necessary for a pupil? (94 RESPONSES)

- d) **Career guidance is not necessary** – 0 (0 %)



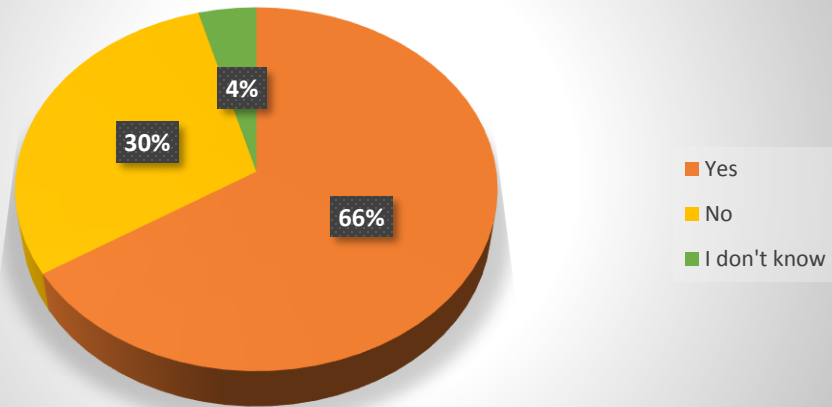
4. 10. Do you think there is a relationship between school subjects and career management? Please explain.

- School subjects can help students to figure out what they like better.

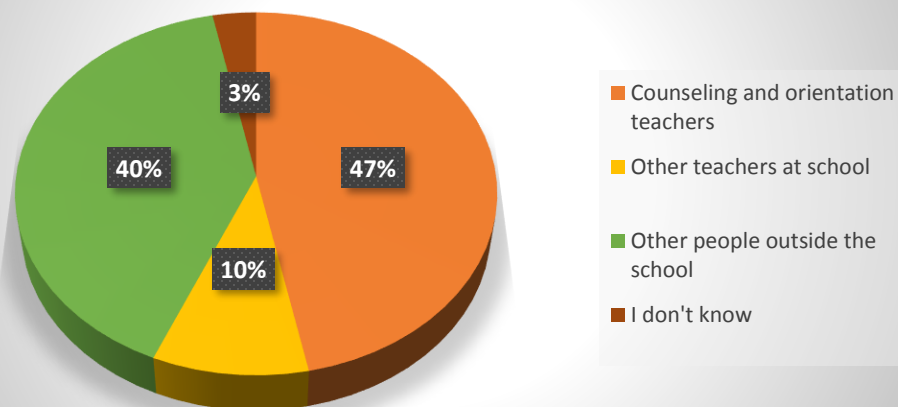
